General Nursery News

Our biggest news is our garden development. As you will have seen, we have a new climbing frame structure with slides for the Red room and Blue room children. We designed this equipment a while ago and have been really excited about seeing it in the garden and watching the children enjoying playing on it.



We have also been busy developing our growing garden area. This is now a green space for the children to relax in with their friends, under the canopy of the blossom tree, with the gentle sound of windchimes, and nature around them.

We have replaced our outdoor water station with a more user-friendly unit and replaced 3 small trampolines as the children thoroughly enjoy them.



We have made a selection of book bag resources for each room to use. The children have really enjoyed some of their favourite stories coming to life with the addition of props linked to each story.

General Reminders

As we (hopefully!) move towards some fairer weather, please bring in a named sun hat for your child to use at nursery. We use the garden spaces in all weathers and temperatures so appropriate clothing and footwear is essential, especially hats in the summer months.

We will be applying suncream when required and there will be a separate information slip coming out to you over the coming weeks for this.

Please can we request, again, that when driving into the car park you adhere to the 5MPH speed limit, or slower. We regularly see parents speed into the car park at unreasonable speeds and this is an accident waiting to happen!

Nursery opens at 07.30 and closes promptly at 18.00. Your nursery fee pays for a maximum 10 hour day and any time after this 10 hours incurs a fine of £1 per minute. Collections after 18.00 are also subject to a fine of £1 per minute and persistent late collections will put your nursery place at risk of cancelation. If you require full feedback about your child's day, please arrive by 17.55 at the latest.

Thank you to the Blue room parents for waiting up at the cloak area for your children to be brought to you. This has really helped the children who find it distressing when they realise it is not their parent coming to collect them yet.

Please do not allow anyone into the nursery behind you as you come in, or as you leave. Politely ask them to ring the appropriate doorbell so staff can let them in. This is help keep our children and team safe.

Breakfast from 8am has worked really well for Red and Blue rooms, please remember if your child attends Blue room and is here before 8am, ring the Red room door bell so the staff can let you in.

As requested previously - on pick up, please don't allow your children to use the nursery garden play equipment. We politely request that you ensure your children stay with you at all times and to leave the nursery site safely after collecting younger ones from the Red room.

Our nursery garden equipment is for the specific 'early years' age groups, with use under adult supervision. Disappointingly one of the brand-new trampolines was damaged one evening during pick up time, before any of the nursery children had a chance to use it.

For safety reasons we don't allow or encourage children to open the garden gate latches or touch the keypad by the front door. This ensures they cannot exit the play spaces or building by themselves and helps to keep them safe.

Thank you for understanding and supporting us with these issues.
